-Briar Nevils places 2nd at Regionals and 5th at Sectionals for Cross Country on 10/26/20 and 10/31/20


-State Horse Evaluation Winners (Olivia Charles placed 8th and Maddie Dauphin placed 81st out of 214 individuals) on 10/29/20
